

CONFRONTING THE THREAT AGAINST TRANS PEOPLE

Florida and the Ominous Shadow Over Utah

We are at a critical juncture where the rights and safety of transgender individuals face severe and relentless attacks. The recent wave of anti-LGBTQ+ legislation in Florida serves as a chilling reminder that revolution and resistance are urgently needed. Florida Governor Ron DeSantis' new bills clearly aim squarely at the LGBTQ+ community, and trans folks in particular. These bills in Florida blatantly target transgender individuals, posing a grave threat to their rights, safety, and overall well-being.

The new legislation casts a dark shadow, sparking deep concerns about discrimination and censorship. House Bill 1069 serves to extend the already controversial "don't say gay" law to include a "don't say trans" limitation in discussions on gender, while Senate Bill 254 callously prohibits critical gender-affirming care. House Bill 1521 imposes cruel restrictions on bathroom access for trans folks, and House Bill 1423 imposes undeserved limitations on drag shows. The newly signed Senate Bill 1580, "Protections of Medical Conscience", dubbed the 'Let Them Die Act', allows medical professionals to refuse treatment, endangering the lives of marginalized communities. As we bear witness to the systematic devaluation and attack against trans people, these discriminatory bills embody the stages of genocide as outlined by Gregory H. Stanton, the president of Genocide Watch, plunging trans communities into a state of terror and marginalization.

"There is evil in this world, and we face it here today," said DeSantis, in

a comment that echoes the divisive tactics used by fear-instilling fascist regimes of the past. This horrifying reality is prompting me to apply Stanton's stages of genocide to the anti-LGBTQ+ legislation in Florida, emphasizing the urgent need for resistance. Stanton's framework of genocidal acts includes classification, symbolization, dehumanization, organization, polarization, preparation, extermination, and denial. As a deeply concerned resident of Utah, I am profoundly disturbed by the governance of Florida Governor DeSantis. The conservative climate in Utah fills me with apprehension. The lives of our trans siblings teeter on the edge of uncertainty, compelling me to respond with a resolute and unyielding call to action. When we look closer, the actions in Florida mirror the dark stages of genocide. Here's a heartbreaking walk-through of these stages as they play out:

Classification:

Trans individuals in Florida are distinctly classified by these bills. They're singled out, separated from the general populace based on their gender identity.

Symbolization:

By giving symbolic labels to trans people, this new legislation creates boundaries around their identities and expression. By dictating who can use what bathroom or who can receive gender-affirming healthcare, they implicitly mark trans individuals, setting them apart from the cisgender population.

Dehumanization:

These bills employ dehumanizing rhetoric, demonizing trans people

and setting the stage for further violations of their rights.

Organization:

The efforts of organized homophobic and anti-trans militia groups that mobilize against trans people highlight the deliberate assault on trans rights. This pattern is mirrored in Utah as we've witnessed these groups right in our own backyard, showing that the threat extends beyond state borders.

Polarization:

Polarization exacerbates divisions and fosters a hostile environment. Those organized militia groups promote a divisive ideology characterized by homophobia, transphobia, xenophobia and white nationalism. Their ideologies attempt to create a sense of "us versus them" and promote hostility towards marginalized communities.

Preparation:

Florida's bills prepare the ground for further harm to trans communities. Denial of healthcare options and service restrictions compromise the safety and well-being of trans people.

Extermination:

The "Protections of Medical Conscience" bill is one example of the chilling manifestation of the seventh stage of genocide—the extermination of targeted groups. By providing legal protection for medical professionals to deny life-saving care, this legislation places the lives of marginalized communities, including trans individuals, in immediate danger.




To our trans siblings in Utah, we stand beside you. Your strength, resilience, and beauty fuel our burning rage.






I'm so tired of this bullshit they try to feed us



The Devil doth reign, with violence and might, Through baron, and priest, and king's delight; A festering wound it is in God's sight.


Saith the Lord, "I'm with the poor!"

THE DOUBLE-EDGED SWORD OF THE DOUBLE-COATED DOG

It's hard to watch members of our family struggle in the heat. It's normal to want to ease their suffering in any way possible. But what seems to be the most obvious solution has unforeseen consequences. Double-coated dogs have two layers of fur: the soft and dense undercoat which grows faster and shorter and the topcoat which is long and usually less dense. But on top of helping the dog stay warm in the winter did you know that the undercoat helps keep them cool in the summer?

Think of the undercoat as insulation, we don't just use insulation in our house during the winter to keep the warmth in. We also use it in the summer to keep the heat out while the AC is blasting inside. Think of the dogs panting as the AC. If you suddenly take away the insulation in summer, it's going to run the AC much harder and longer to maintain an appropriate temperature. It is for this reason and many others that it is important to not shave double-coated dogs unless they meet very specific circumstances.

Some of the most common breeds which have double coats are the German Shephard, Great Pyranese, Pomeranian, Corgis, Chow-Chows, and even Retrievers. You can check your dog's breed description online to find out if it's listed as having a double coat if you don't already know. You can also ask your vet at your next visit.

While shaving a double-coated dog may seem like it would cause less shedding it actually doesn't because shedding is the release of the fur from follicles on the skin, and shaving only shortens the hair; it doesn't remove it. Shaving can also lead to issues such as razor burns, hot spots, irritated skin, and a condition called shave shock which is caused by the clippers getting too hot, in the blink of an eye it can cause trauma to the top coat preventing it from growing back correctly. Even if you have the best groomer in the world, they do not have heat vision and won't notice right away that their equipment has overheated. Even after leaving the groomers your dog is at additional risk of issues like sunburn and skin cancer.

So what can we do to make them comfortable in the heat and prevent matting or fur compaction? First, it's always recommended to brush your dog daily. I don't mean a full brush every single day but try to focus on specific parts of the body over the week. Secondly, monthly baths with de-shedding shampoo. Unlike with humans, you may need to do more than one shampoo and/or conditioning during bath time to have the best results, this can be laborious and painful. I highly recommend using a quality conditioner because it can help prevent matting between baths. Exposing your dog to this at a young age can mean all the difference in making it tolerable to you both. Third, it is very important to not let your double-coated dog air dry.

They will rub their head and body across any surface they can to get the water out of their fur, but they are also causing compaction of the fur by creating tighter and tighter knots close to the skin. Pat them dry with a towel, don't rub them. Then use a hand-held blow dryer to get air to the skin which will prevent compaction, it will also help pull some of the released undercoat toward the end of the hair it is already knotted around. This will make brushing out your dog at the end much easier. Compacted fur will lead to a lack of airflow and cause pulling on the skin that will cause additional irritation as well as dry patches of skin or fungal infection if it remains too moist after getting wet. Fourth, look into purchasing an undercoat rake for dogs or an EquiGroomer, these two kinds of brushes work wonders on pulling undercoat fur out, reducing shed. Just be careful to not over brush while using these tools.


Regular appointments with a groomer may be costly, but if you aren't up to the labor of this task it is best to have them do it, for dog's sake! They can also do a blowout on your dog's fur which uses a high-velocity blow dryer, making them look ridiculously fluffy after their grooming appointment.

Some exceptions to the no-shaving rule include

- 1.It's an outdoor dog. Still do not shave your dog's undercoat. Instead, it is recommended to shave away fur in the belly/inguinal area and avoid the area over the ribs. This will allow a better transfer of heat when your dog lays down on a cold surface. This area of the dog's body does not have a lot of dense undercoat and minimizes the risk of the issues mentioned above.
- 2. The pet is too matted or uncomfortable to be bathed and brushed out. As the dog gets older the quality of the fur will decrease leaving them at higher risk of getting matted easily, and as they suffer old age brushing regularly might be painful. In these conditions improving their comfort is the top priority. But be mindful of the risk of sunburn, a shirt can help reduce the risk.

3. Your dog is a swimmer. It could become difficult to stay on top of all these steps to prevent matting if your dog regularly goes for swims.

Dogs are our best friends. They are a part of our families and mean the world to us. We owe it to them to repay their love with the best care we can offer.
